
WHAT'S THE WEATHER?

Sunny weather means the sun is shining and it's bright outside.






Cloudy weather means there are lots of clouds in the sky and it might not be as bright outside.


During a storm, thunder booms and lightning flashes. Rain and strong winds can also happen during a storm.

Each snowflake has a unique shape and design. No two snowflakes are exactly alike!






When it is windy, the air is moving quickly and we can feel it blowing around us.

Rainy weather is when water falls from the sky in the form of raindrops.






An umbrella protects us from rain. It keeps us dry by creating a roof above our heads.
