

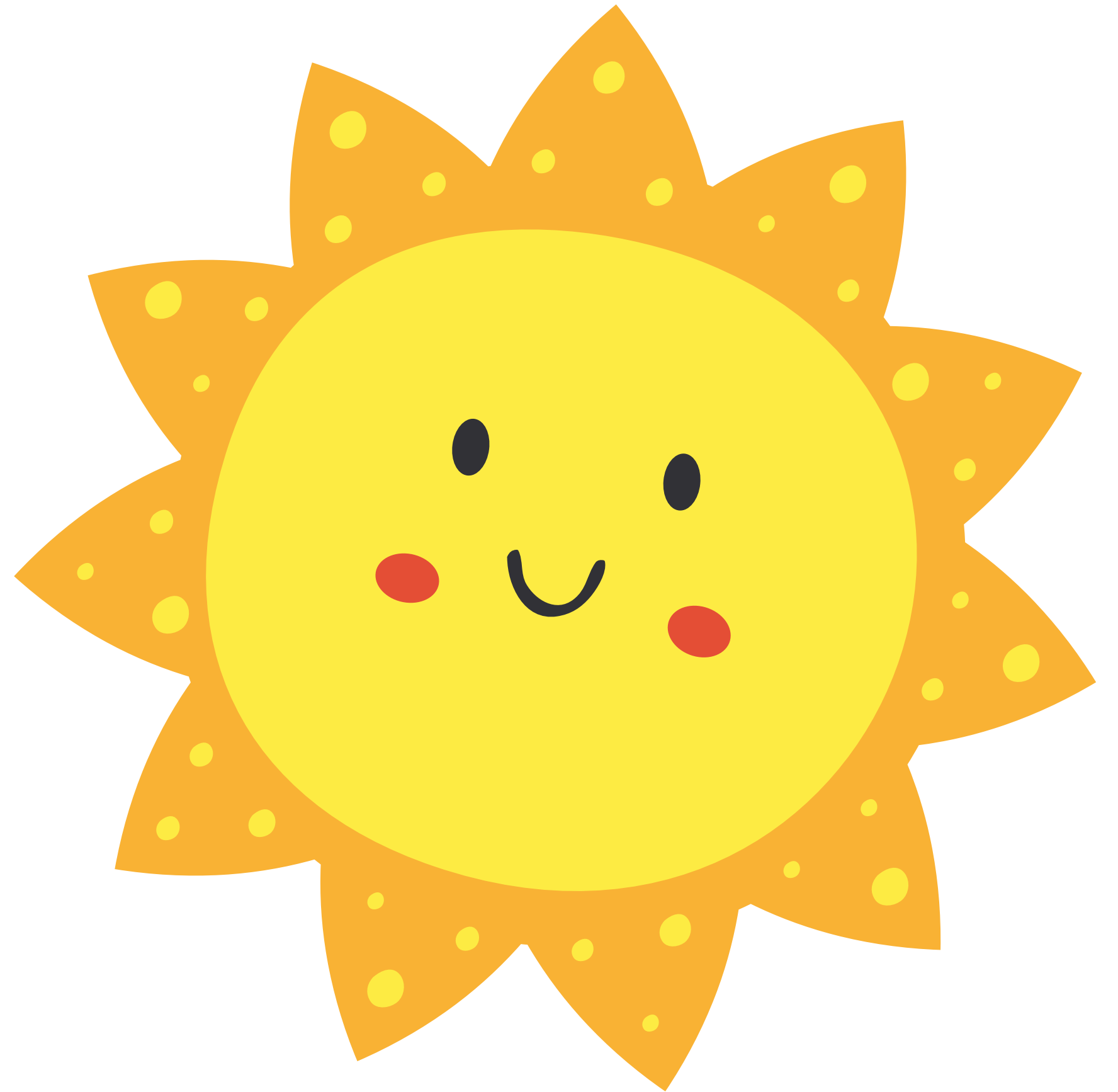
WHAT'S THE WEATHER?

Weather is the different conditions we experience outside, like how hot or cold it is, how windy it is, and if it's raining or sunny.

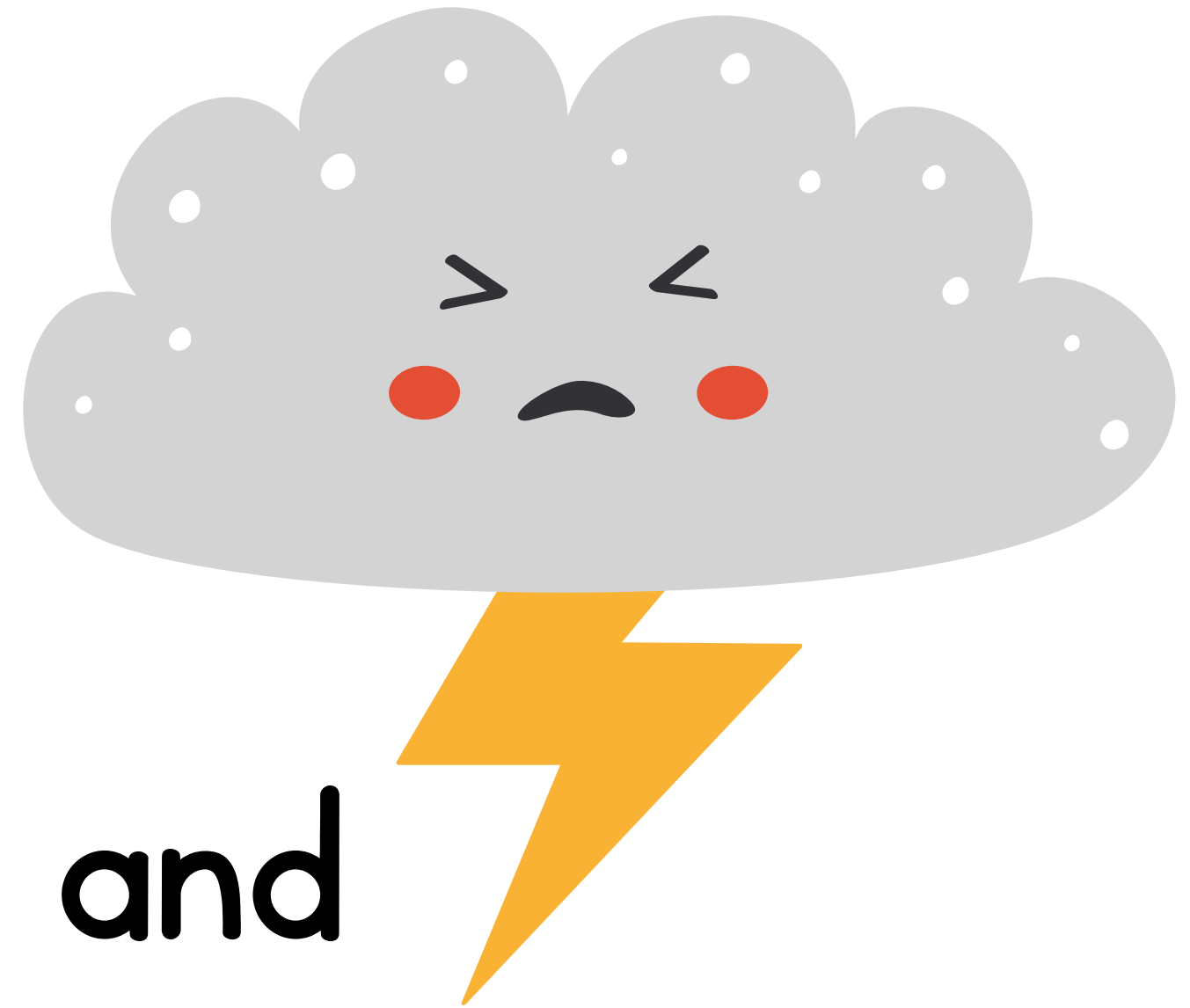
Sunny weather

bright outside.

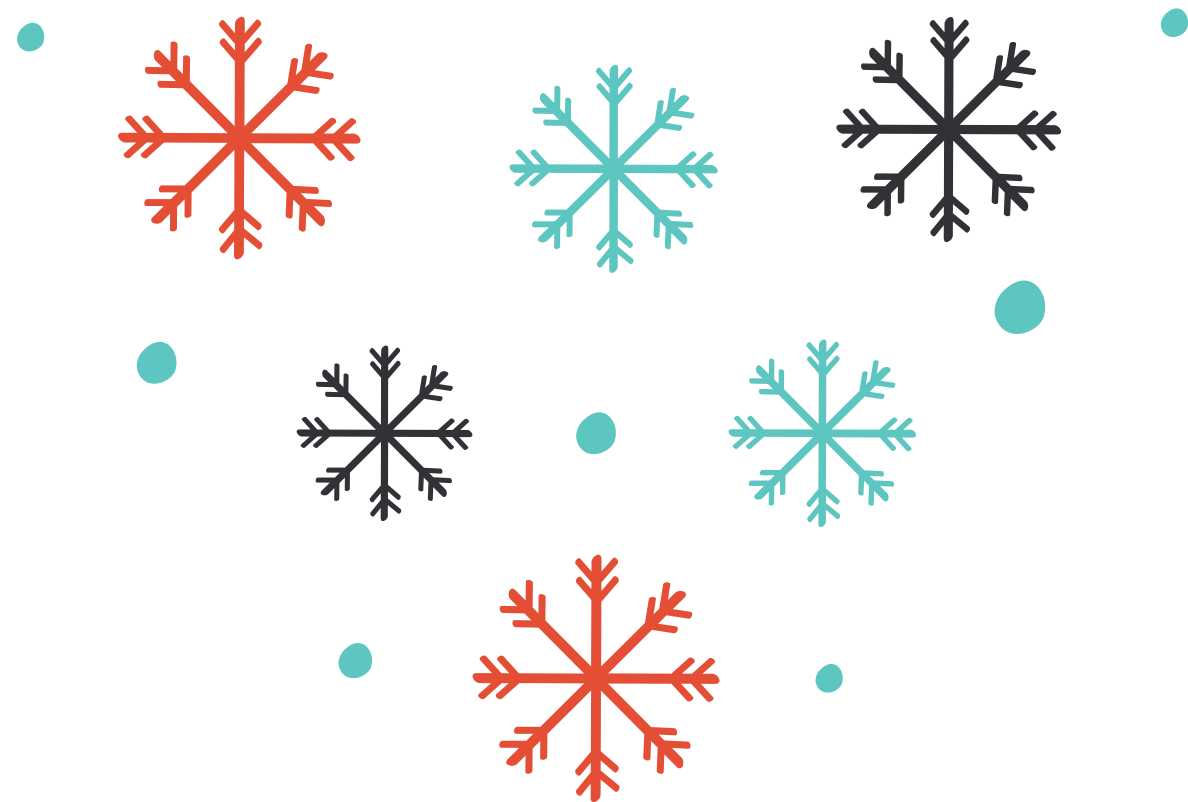




Cloudy weather means there are lots of clouds in the sky and it might not be as bright outside.

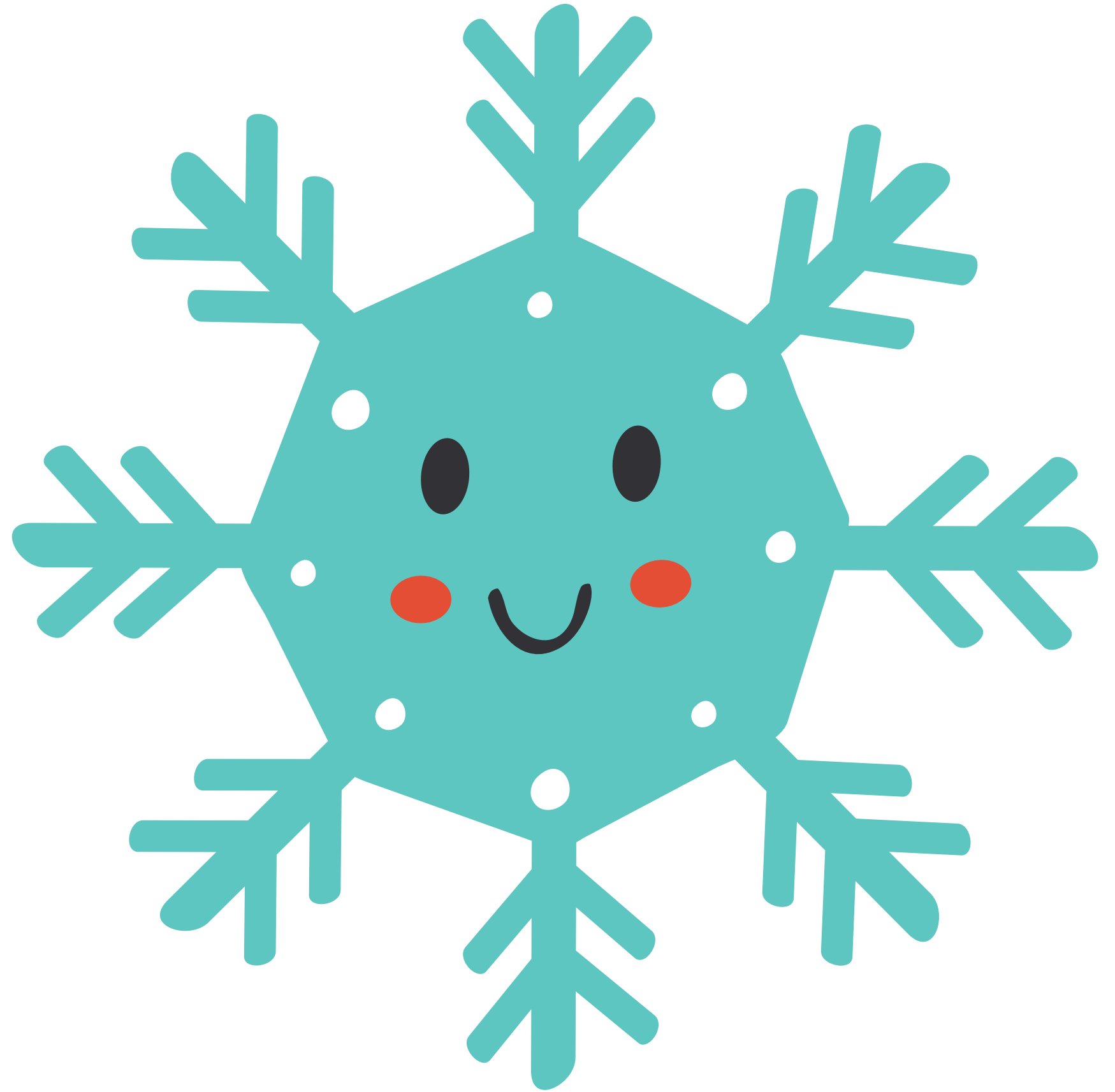
During a storm,

happen during a storm.

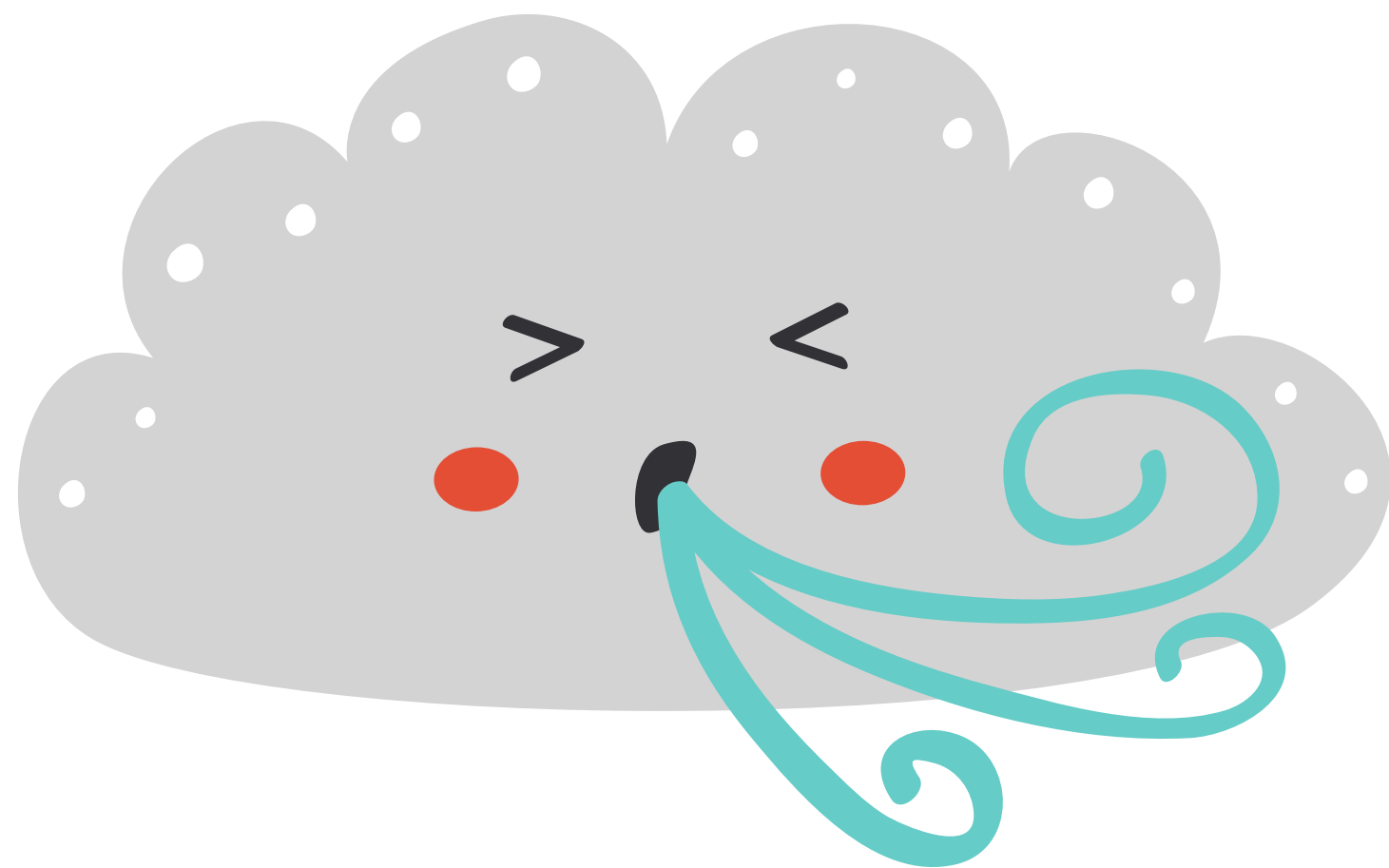




Snowy

raindrops.

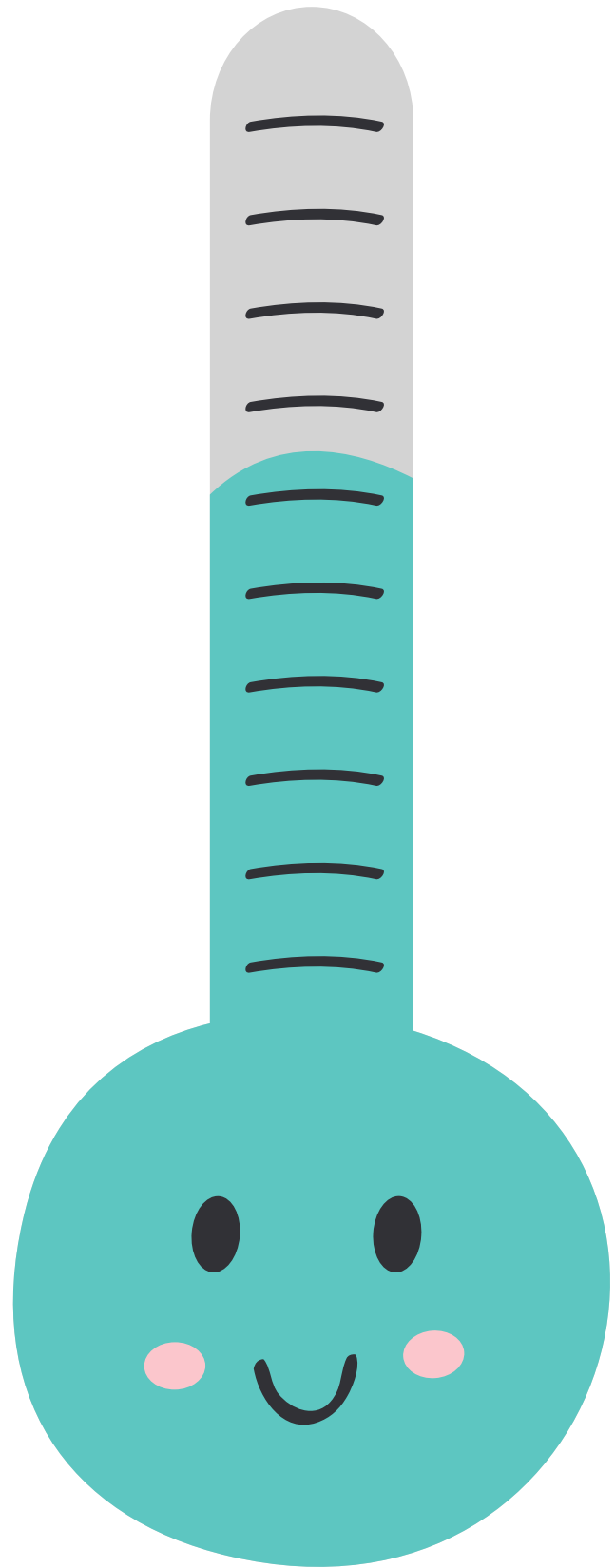




An umbrella
